Wildfires are very dangerous, spreading fast, changing direction, threatening wildlife, livestock, domestic animals, environment, property and people.

If you see a fire, however small, CALL 999 IMMEDIATELY
Fire setting is an offence, don't accept it, report it!

If you see or suspect someone of acting suspiciously, recklessly or irresponsibly in the countryside **contact Police Scotland on 101** or pass information anonymously to **Scotland Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111**.
